

January 2011 Minutes

The Town Board of Holland met Monday, January 3rd 2011. Chairman Wall called the meeting to order, the pledge of allegiance was recited, the minutes of the December meeting were read and motion was made by Sup Geiger to approve, seconded by Sup Vande Wetering. Motion passed.

Chairman Wall asked if there was any Old Business. There was a discussion on the speed of automobiles in Hollandtown. The chairman stated, "...there is a 15 mph going past the school and the curve on CE..." It was brought up that maybe a petition for a slower speed would be considered by Brown County Traffic Department.

New Business- the subject of wind turbines was discussed, Carl Johnson stated "...that the Legislature didn't act before it adjourned and he hoped with the new governor and legislature there could be a reconsideration of the PSC Citing rules." It was suggested by Sup Geiger that the town should send an email to the new governor, requesting he change the wind turbine citing rules. A second was given to that motion by sup Vande Wetering further stating that they(wind turbines) follow the Town of Holland ordinance and stating that a wind turbine could not be constructed within one half mile of a dwelling. Motion passed unanimously.

Next, a letter to the Town of Buchanan was written, giving the locations of the sections that each is responsible for maintain roads.

Next item was the appointment of Butch Jeske to the planning board. A motion to approve was made by Sup Geiger and seconded by Sup Vande Wetering, motion passed.

The payment of bills was next on the agenda, after review a motion was made by Sup Vande Wetering to pay the bills, seconded by Sup Geiger, motion passed.

Being there no other business, a motion to adjourn was made by Sup Geiger, seconded by Sup Vande Wetering, meeting was adjourned.
