

The Town Board of Holland met Monday June 6th at 8:00pm. Chairman Wall called the meeting to order and the pledge of allegiance was recited. The minutes of the May meeting were read, a motion to approve them was made by Sup Van De Wattering, seconded by Sup Geiger, motion passed.

Old Business: Mark Eiting from Holland Athletic association presented a bill for renovation done at their park, the board then approved a \$1500.00 payment from funds designated for park maintenance. A question was raised as to whether or not the Holland Athletic Association needed to have an insurance policy for beer served. Mr. Eiting will be checking into this matter with his insurance agent.

Open Forum: none.

New Business: Scott Construction Company presented their bid for the refurbishing of New Road, the cost for the project was \$44,924.00. A motion to accept the bid was made by Supervisor Van de Wattering, a second made by Sup Geiger, motion passed.

Another item brought forward was the matter of the ditch along the Holland Park running to Van Street. It was stated that lawn mowers were getting stuck and therefore unable to cut grass. Chairman Wall stated that he would check with Brown County Highway Department to see if the grade was correct. He also stated that the board would go over to check and see if tile could be laid in the bottom of the ditch.

The next item concerned the Brown County Highway Department requesting a formal reply that the Town of Holland declined to request funds for the Bridge Fund. Chairman Wall stated that the town had over \$300,000.00 in the fund and it would have to be expensed before any more funds could be raised. After review, the board signed a statement stating that they would not request any funding for bridge projects for the 2011 calendar year.

The next item involved the Town Board of Holland passing a resolution going on record to support the present 26 member Brown County Board of Supervisors. A motion was made by Sup Geiger to that effect, seconded by Sup Van de Wattering, motion passed unanimously.

Payment of Bills: After review, a motion was made to pay them was made by Sup Geiger, seconded by Sup Van de Wattering, motion passed.

Being there no other business, a motion to adjourn was made by Sup Geiger, seconded by Sup Van de Wattering, meeting adjourned.
