

The Town Board of Holland met Monday December 5th at 8:00 PM. Chairman Wall called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The minutes of the November meeting were read, a motion by sup Vande Wetering was made to approve, seconded by sup Geiger, motion passed.

Old Business: Sup Geiger stated that he again was called regarding a reoccurring smoke problem. The Board reviewed the issue and Sup Geiger was to refer the reporting party to the town's attorney, to discuss the matter with him. Sup Geiger stated that he has been busy taking care of dog, cat and rabbit problems resulting from people dropping off animals. The board stated that the service provided by Sup Geiger was highly valued and requested that he keep up the good work.

New Business: Yvonne Deyo addressed the board and said that there would be recycling every other Tuesday for the year 2012. A motion to approve the change was made by Sup Geiger, seconded by Sup Vande Wetering, motion passed.

The clerk presented the special assessments to be placed on the tax role, after review, a motion to approve was made by Sup Vande Wetering, seconded by Sup Geiger, motion passed. The Town Board changed the date of the January 2012 meeting to Tuesday January 3rd, please note the change.

The board was informed that there was little activity after 12 noon at the recycling center, a motion was made by Sup Vande Wetering to change the hours to 9:00 AM to Noon, seconded by Sup Geiger, motion passed.

Brown County Planning submitted a map to the town board to be reviewed and approved. The board found that one parcel was omitted from the working lands initiative and suggested that the clerk correct the map and submit the revised edition back to Brown County Planning.

Payment of Bills: after review of bills, motion to approve payment was made by Sup Vande Wetering, seconded by Sup Geiger, motion passed.

Being there no other business, motion adjourn was made by Sup Geiger and seconded by Sup Vande Wettering, meeting adjourned.
